The Heart of the Matter

Contrasts dot the landscape of Scripture. Light and dark. Heaven and hell. Love and hate. Faith and works. Freedom and bondage. Life and death. 1. A Study in Contrasts

The Bible is filled with contrasts, none more significant than God's merciful choice to bring believers from death to life.

2. From Death to Life: Five Questions (Ephesians 2:1–10)

Answering these five significant questions allows us to see clearly God's action on our behalf: What was life like? What did God do? Why would God ever do that? How can this be? What difference does this make?



Starting Your Journey


Don't be fooled into thinking that those without hope in Christ have found lasting fulfillment. Instead, remember that lasting relief only comes by grace through faith.




